(Policy for the Association of Organizations with FSC®)

Bingaman & Son Lumber, Inc. is associated with the Forest Stewardship Council A.C., Oaxaca, Mexico, or one of its subsidiaries or affiliates (hereinafter: FSC®) by being either a member of or having a contractual relationship with FSC®. Hereby, Bingaman & Son Lumber, Inc. explicitly states that it has read and understood the “Policy for the Association of Organizations with FSC®” as published under [www.FSC.org](http://www.FSC.org). This policy stipulates FSC®’s position with regards to unacceptable activities by organizations and individuals which already are or would like to be associated with FSC® as well as the mechanism for disassociation.

In light of the above, Bingaman & Son Lumber, Inc. explicitly agrees currently and in the future, as long as the relationship with FSC® exists, not be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities:

- a) Illegal logging or the trade in illegal wood or forest products;
- b) Violation of traditional and human rights in forestry operations;
- c) Destruction of high conservation values in forestry operations;
- d) Significant conversion of forests to plantations or non-forest use;
- e) Introduction of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations;
- f) Violation of any of the ILO Core Conventions as defined in the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work.
